# Land Use Update- Greg

- Wildflower development- has been approved, and will start next spring.
  - A compromise struck at the city council meeting- agreed to reserve a portion of the space to change the zoning at the end. It will be 1.4 acres including Wilson extension.
  - The next process that the neighbors will want to speak on- the raised crossing, might want to ask for more speed bumps or something leading into it.
  - 581 dwellings going in there
  - There is a neighborhood street safety program coming and we could petition for a safe crossing on 15th where the new development is going in.
  - Going for market rate
- **Parkside place-** Not officially a part of Larkspur yet. Has been annexed in the city but is not officially a part of a neighborhood at this point.
  - The project is being run by Hayden Homes.
  - 40% affordable housing- roughly income of \$74,000/ year.
- **Community Question**: Is the bus district involved? Will there be more bus stops? They are adding routes to Parkside Place but not sure about the Wildflower development.
- Holiday Inn- proposal to change the Inn on 3rd into a condominium.

# Transportation Update- Greg

- 15th and Wilson roundabout- proposed to be done at the end of May
- The whole project goes from 2nd to 15th, will be doing 9th to centennial next, and then they will likely do 2nd-3rd, etc. Part of the Go Bond from 2020.
- Community Comments- The Bend Elks Fence is terrible, owned by Parks and Rec. Can they do something with the fence while they are working on this corridor?
